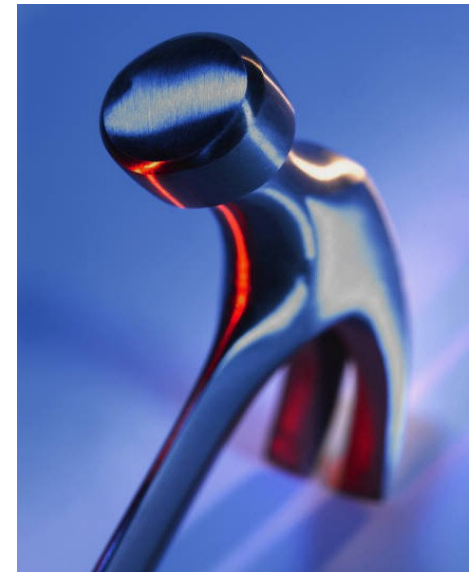

On November 17th 2007, we had Mr. Sam Dasch, a CPA with the firm of Gallina, LLP talk to us about tax strategies.
